DEED OR DECLARATION OF TRUST FOR RUNNING AN
EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION

THIS DEED OF DECLARATION OF TRUST IS executed
on the 18th day of January, 1997 by Mrs. Nellie Ahmed
Tanweer, aged about 40 years, daughter of Late Bakto
Jamal Ahmed and residing at Ramse Hills Kharguli,
Guwahati.


WHEREAS I the said Mrs. Nellie Ahmed Tanweer
have already set apart a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees
fifty thousand) in cash towards constituting a trust
for the purpose of founding an educational institution
for the education and training of boys and girls in
educative and vocational pursuits and to provide a good
and healthy climate to the Educational Institution to
fulfill its aims and objects and to provide quality
education as a centre for educational excellence and
the said sum having been handed over to the trustees
hereinafter appearing :

AND WHEREAS the trustees have also accepted
the trust fund as stated above

AND WHEREAS it has become necessary to declare
the objects and terms of the TRUST



NOW THIS DEED OF DECLARATION OF TRUST for
running an educational institution WITNESSES as
under :

1. The name of the Trust shall be MARIA'S PUBLIC EDUCATIONAL TRUST and its office shall be for the present at Zoo Road, Guwahati and at such other place or places as the trustees herein may decide from time-to-time.
2. The first trustees of the trust shall be :
 - (i) Mrs. Nellie Ahmed Tanweer (Author of the Trust).
 - (ii) Shri Ataur Rahman, Ex-Member of Parliament and retired Inspector General of Police, Ramps Hills, Kharguli, Guwahati.
 - (iii) Shri Basistha Dev Phukan, retired CBSR Regional Director, Gandhi Basti, Guwahati-3.
 - (iv) Shri Sada Nanda Moral, Ramps Hills, Kharguli, Guwahati.
 - (v) Shri Sajidur Rahman, Ramps Hills, Kharguli, Guwahati.
 - (vi) Shri Hemen Shankar Saikia, Chenikuthi, Guwahati.

3. Mrs. Nellie Ahmed Tapweer shall be designated as the Managing Trustee who shall be in charge of the day-to-day affairs of the Trust. The Managing Trustee shall hold office for life or until she resigns therefrom and during her life-time shall name the successor to the Managing Trustee on such terms and conditions as the Managing Trustee or as the case may be the Board of Trustees deem fit.

4. The Managing Trustee shall have overall power of superintendence over affairs of the Trust and shall have in particular the power to operate the bank accounts, for the trust and carry out the objects of the trust.

5. The Managing Trustee shall have power to administer the funds of the Trust and any power exercisable by the Board of Trustees as may be delegated to the Managing Trustee.

6. The proper accounts for the trust shall be kept at the office of the trust. The initial contribution of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) made by the author of the trust shall hereby vest in the trustees and shall constitute the initial trust fund.

7. The trust fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contributions from time-to-time.

8. The funds of the trust shall not be applied for any purpose other than THE OBJECTS of the trust hereinafter stated :

- (a) To open, run, own, acquire, establish, continue an educational and vocational institution in healthy surroundings with special privileges and attention shown to disabled children ;
- (b) To ensure that the educational and vocational institution gets proper land, building, equipment, furniture and qualified staff at least as necessary for Affiliation and as per norms of the Central Board of Secondary Education ;
- (c) To ensure that the educational and vocational institution is run as a community ~~business~~ and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever ;
- (d) To ensure that the funds accruing from the said educational institution are spent for the benefit of the school and for its expansion ;

- (e) To ensure that the said educational institution has the basic essential facilities such as Library equipment, equipment for games and sports and other co-curricular activities, library books, etc.
- (f) To safeguard the autonomy of the Principal and provide him/her total support except when the Principal goes against the established and clear directives laid down by the management committee of the educational institution.
- (g) To have control over the management committee of the educational institution and to approve the budget/tuition fees and annual charges etc. of the said institution.
- (h) To have control over any capital expenditure, i.e. on land and the construction of building, its expansion and procurement of major equipments for the educational institution;
- (i) To generate funds for the needs of the educational institution whether it is recurring or non-recurring;
- (j) To have the powers to constitute Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committees for various categories of staff;

(k) To engage teachers, instructors and experts of good moral character and capable of imparting efficiently and economically up-to-date instruction to students in intellectual and other usual pursuits;

(l) To have powers to lay down conditions of service as per norms of the Central Board of Secondary Education/Government and to approve of promotion/appointment/termination of the employees as well as to grant increments or rewards to the staff;

(m) To ensure that the educational institution is running as per the provisions of the Education Act/Affiliation Norms and committed to provide quality education to the students by taking necessary steps as required.

9. Rules may be framed for the proper administration of the trust, but such rules shall not be against the objects of the trust hereinbefore mentioned. For the removal of doubts it is hereby declared that this trust, its objects and its implementation shall not be for the benefit of any particular caste or religious community as such.

10. The Board of Trustee shall have the power to acquire immovable or movable properties for the trust and likewise the power to sell, lease or mortgage

or otherwise deal with such properties and/or to
create charge against the properties of the Trust.

11. The Board of Trustees may out of the corpus
of the subject matter of the Trust, spend such money
or appropriate such money or part thereof for laying
out, erecting and furnishing any building or for
incurring any capital expenditure as may be resolved
upon by the majority decision of the Trustees.

12. The Board of Trustees may at any time invite
and receive or without such invitation receive any
voluntary contributions from any person or persons
whatsoever, within or outside the country, by way of
donation or annual or other subscription or otherwise
for the support or for the benefit of the Trust hereby
constituted.

13. The Board of Trustees shall have the power
to borrow money from financial institutions/Banks etc.
and for that matter pay interest etc. to the concerned
financial institution/Bank. The Board shall also arrange
Third Party Guarantee/Security against any borrowing by
the Trust.

14. Every power, authority or discretion herein-
before or hereinafter conferred upon the Board of
Trustees shall be exercised either by some instrument
in writing to be signed by all the Trustees or by the
resolution of a majority of the Trustees who shall be

present and vote at a meeting of the Trustees provided that the notice of intention to hold such meeting and of the business to be transacted there shall have been given to all the Trustees and provided that not less than three of the Trustees shall attend and vote upon the question to be decided by the resolution. The Managing Trustee cum the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote in case of equality of votes for and against any resolution.

15. The Trustees are hereby authorized to appoint a Secretary and to pay him/her out of the Trust fund shall salary as the Trustees think fit provided that if one of the Trustees is appointed Secretary, he/she shall not be entitled to be paid any salary unless otherwise provided by the resolution of a majority of the Trustees. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to summon meeting of the Trustees and enter minutes of all proceedings at such meeting in the minutes book. A copy of any minutes of any resolution or other act or proceeding of the Trustees certified in writing by the Secretary for the time being to be a true copy thereof shall be conclusive evidence for all purposes of the passing, doing or taking of such resolution, act or proceeding and of the meeting at which the same took place having been duly convened and held, and of the regularity of all proceedings thereat and of the appointment of the person certifying the copy as such Secretary.

16. It shall be lawful for the Trustees for the time being of these presents, with the consent of the managing Trustee, to reimburse themselves or himself or

herself pay and discharge out of the Trust properties all cost, charges and expenses incurred in the carrying out of these presents or in or about the execution of the Trust or powers of these presents.

17. The number of Trustees shall not be less than three or more than six and in all meetings of the Trustees three will form the quorum.

18. In case of any difference between the Trustees the opinion of the majority shall prevail subject to the acquiescence/casting vote of the Managing Trustee.

19. Upon the appointment of a new Trustee the Trust properties shall also vest in the new Trustee jointly with the continuing or surviving Trustees with the power and subject to the Trust hereby created.

20. When any vacancies arise in the Board of Trustees on account of death, incapacity or persistent neglect of any Trustee, or on retirement with thirty days prior notice, the remaining Trustees may co-opt any person of status, provided, however, that no such person shall be co-opted if the Trust by its three fourths majority does not approve of such selection alongwith the casting vote of the Managing Trustee. Until such time the vacancy or vacancies are not duly filled up, the remaining Trustees shall constitute the Board of Trustees.

21. Any question arising in the administration of the Trust shall be decided by the majority of the Trustees acting for the time being.

22. After defraying of necessary expenditure incurred in the subject matter of the Trust, any portion of the surplus generated by the Trust shall be transferred to the General Reserve Fund for utilisation in case of emergency and as decided by the majority opinion of the Trustees expressed in a joint meeting of the Trustees presided over by the Managing Trustee from year to year.

23. The Managing Trustee may authorise any of the Trustees to act on her/his behalf and to operate Bank accounts etc.

24. The Trustees shall have power to appoint personnel to organise and promote the objects of the trust and to regulate their conditions of service, including matters of discipline.

25. All acts and proceedings of the trust shall be taken and conducted in the name of the Trust.

26. This Trust is irrevocable.
